IYT Worldwide REQUIREMENTS - COLOUR BLINDNESS

Before embarking on your Training you should ascertain whether you will meet the Colour blindness requirement for passing the physical exam. You will be required to respond to a test known as the Ishihara Test, and asked to look at over 14 different plates with colour patterns and identify a number or object within each plate. An example is shown below,

if you cannot distinguish a number in each plate you would be advised to have a full colour blindness assessment done.

Please note being able to see the numbers in the following plates is NOT a conclusive test and IYT Worldwide does not give any warranty that you will pass a formal Ishihara test given by a qualified doctor/optometrist. All candidates should satisfy themselves and undertake a formal colour blindness test.
